



Parishes of Harden and Wilsden

The thought provoking material prepared by women in the Philippines was presented by voices from each church. Some of the songs were unfamiliar and musically challenging (!) but overall the service was inspiring and ended with a resolution to seek to be 'instruments of fairness, justice and joy.'

During Fair Trade Fortnight we are reminded that many of our foodstuffs are produced in developing countries where small farmers experience severe poverty and cannot afford basic things we take for granted. Buying products from Traidcraft we are sure that the producers have been paid a fair rate for their skills. Their development arm provides training and education in modern farming methods. One of many farmers benefitting from improved conditions is Adriano, a tea plucker in Tanzania. He says "I have been able to build a house using mud bricks and the Fair Trade Fund have given me iron sheets for the roof. I can pay for my daughter to go to school. Please ask people in the UK to keep buying our tea to help improve our life conditions."

The Children's Society house box collection at St. Matthew's raised the sum of £360.19p which is an increase on last year. Thank you to everyone who contributed to this very worthy charity who do lots of work in our area. Margaret Robertshaw
