



# Parishes of Harden and Wilsden

**Place of Welcome** The Places of Welcome scheme is a national initiative that has been taken up jointly by Bradford Council and our Bradford Episcopal Area. It aims to provide places for people to come to be together where there is free hospitality, including refreshments and friendship, also with simple activities. It is especially aimed at loneliness which affects rich and poor, young and old, and people of any faith or none. We are launching a Place of Welcome at St Matthews on Friday 7th July from 10.00 to 12.00 and it will then be open at that same time every week.  
We have a team of volunteers for Friday mornings, but there are other ways of helping too. It would be lovely to be able to offer some home baked biscuits or cake, but we don't want to be overwhelmed with this, as numbers are likely to be small, especially during the start-up period.  
We have put a baking sign up list on the notice board at St Matthews (St Saviours people could support by liaising through the clergy or via Helen Ludkin). If anyone is willing please put your name against a particular date and then just show up at about 10.00 on the Friday concerned to bring your contribution.
