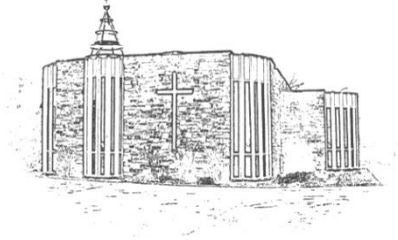


Parishes of Harden and Wilsden

Bradford Cathedral is celebrating the centenary of its cathedral status with a wide range of activities.

The programme covering May to August is available in both our churches.

Acts 435 is a revolutionary website that allows people to give money directly to others.
