Vestry Roof Collapses

Bishop of Bradford's Narrow Escape

The Bishop of Bradford had a narrow escape at the Wilsden Parish Church on Sunday morning. The roof of the vestry, in which he had been sitting previous to occupying the pulpit, fell with a crash when he was about half-way through his sermon.

The bishop had been sitting at a table in the vestry before entering the church, and about three-quarters of an hour after he left the room the congregation was alarmed by hearing a loud crash.

Upon investigation it was found that half of the roof had fallen on and around the identical chair upon which the bishop had sat, bringing with it a large amount of plaster, laths and other building material. Had the fall taken place when the bishop was in the room there is no doubt he would have been seriously injured, if not worse, for the amount of debris which fell was of considerable weight and fell from a great height. The service was a special one conducted by the Bishop to commemorate the one hundredth anniversary of the church and a particularly large congregation was present. The Bishop did not allow it to interrupt his sermon.
