Monday 13 June	Pray for Ukraine, for all who have lost family and homes and for an end to killing and destruction.
Tuesday 14 June	Pray for refugees, from Ukraine and from other situations of fear and hardship that we know much less about.
Wednesday 15 June	Pray for our political leaders and those who represent our country in the eyes of the world.
Thursday 16 June	Pray for the planet and responsible use of its resources by nations, businesses and individuals.
Friday 17 June	Pray for farmers, particularly for working farms within our benefice.
Saturday 18 June	Give thanks for the lovely countryside around our villages, the walks and views to refresh and cheer us.
