

#### **Winter Coats Appeal.**

Harden Congregational Church are hosting an appeal in support of the Immanuel Project in Bradford, caring for the homeless and vulnerable in the city.



They ask for coats, hats, gloves and scarves in good condition for men and women.

Also very welcome are donations of new socks, underwear and toiletries. Kitchen items and cutlery are also very useful.

The church will be open on the mornings of Friday 17th and Saturday 18th October to receive donations.

St Ives (Bingley) Riding for the Disabled, a local charity based at Aireview Equestrian Centre, is looking to expand its services. We have a growing waiting list of children and older people with various physical and emotional challenges who need our help to develop their confidence and well-being through interaction with horses, something that is proven to be extremely effective and rewarding for both riders and volunteers. We operate on Monday (10.30-5.00), Wednesday (10.30-3.30) and Thursday (10.00-3.00), we are looking to increase our hours on Thursday to accommodate new and existing riders. In order to achieve this, we are seeking volunteers to join our current team. Ideally prospective volunteers should have some experience with horses, though full training and supervision of all aspects of the role are provided.
