Christian Aid Week 15-21 May 2022

Christian Aid is a global movement of people, churches, and local organisations. We are the changemakers, the peacemakers, the mighty of heart. Everyone is equal in the sight of God. Yet we live in a world where poverty persists. We work with local partners and communities to fight injustice, respond to humanitarian emergencies, campaign for change, and help people claim the services and rights they are entitled to. Poverty is an outrage against humanity. It robs people of their dignity and lets injustice thrive. But together we have the power to transform lives. For over 70 years, we've been standing with the poorest of our neighbours. We work in 37 countries, with people of all faiths and none, to stand up for dignity, equality, and justice. Together we can create a world where everyone can live a full life, free from poverty. Our voices and actions are stronger together. And with your help, we can make an even bigger difference. This year the focus is particularly on supporting women in Zimbabwe who struggle to feed their families. New methods of farming are needed in the face of climate change.
