#### Following the Resignation of the Archbishop of Canterbury

On Tuesday afternoon the Archbishop of Canterbury announced his resignation following actions taken on a safeguarding issue investigated in the Makin Report.In his resignation statement he said that "it is very clear that I must take personal and institutional responsibility."

Our thoughts and prayers are with survivors, victims and all who have been abused at the hands of others.

This is a reminder that Safeguarding is the responsibility of all of us. Anyone can be the person to whom someone turns for help, support or to share a concern. It is important that everyone knows what to do if that should happen. Most importantly do not keep silent. Each of our churches has someone to speak to: Harden: Anne Palmer, Wilsden: Mary Ryan, Cullingworth: Judy Mason, Denholme: Judith Drake. You can also speak Richard, Liz, Alison or Anna. Most of the PCC members have also had training in both Safeguarding Foundations and Domestic Abuse Awareness.

And we would like to offer this training again to everyone. So everyone is invited to come to Wilsden Church at 7pm on Wednesday 8 January to do the Safeguarding Foundation training course together. When the PCC members did it last time it was an inspiring evening as we learned and talked together. We will offer the Foundation Training again the Spring on Tuesday 22 April at 7pm. On Tuesday 13 May everyone is welcome to Denholme Shared Church at 7pm for the Domestic Abuse Awareness Training.

Everyone who came last time spoke of how helpful these short courses were and how good it was to learn together. We are very aware of how those who came are much better equipped than those who have not attended. That is why we would like to strongly encourage everyone to come along.

And don't feel that you have to wait for those dates if you wish to get some training immediately. We found it very useful to do the courses together, but if you go to: This link on the Diocesan Website you will find the same courses, which you can do on your own.

I do hope that you will join us for this incredibly important training. You never know when it will be vital for you that you did it.
