The church councils met following the announcement of the "Emergence Roadmap" by the Prime Minister on 23 February. It is encouraging that three weeks into the first section of our journey, the data seems encouraging for continuing lockdown easing. The church councils have thought carefully about the current situation and all our churches will be open on Sundays from Easter Morning. We must still exercise great caution, so we are asking people to book in. Masks must be worn and distancing observed and sadly we are not able to sing.

The churches will also begin be open again for personal prayer for an hour on Wednesday afternoons and there is a service in each church on the evenings of Holy Week and on Good Friday.
