Sunday 29 May	Pray for the work of Compassion UK, World Vision and other charities helping children and their communities in some of the world's poorest countries
Monday 30 May	Pray for Christians in Sudan and for progress in the move towards a fair and acceptable form of government. Pray for the safety of peaceful protestors opposed to the military coup
Tuesday 31 May	Pray for the situation in Ukraine and for all who are genuinely trying to find a way to bring an end to the death and destruction.
Wednesday 1 June	Pray for members of the UK Parliament, of all parties, that they will work compassionately and justly in the service of all those they represent.
Thursday 2 June	Pray for people you know, and others in our villages, who are still finding it difficult to access health care or facing long delays in treatment.
Friday 3 June	Pray for all who work in Bradford and Airedale hospitals as they still face staff shortages while trying to catch up with postponed treatments.
Saturday 4 June	At the start of the Jubilee weekend, pray for the Queen and give thanks for her long and dedicated service.
