Sunday 3 November	As we have changed from British Summer Time, pray for lonely and vulnerable people in our communities who find the long dark evenings a time of increased anxiety.
Monday 4 November	Pray for compassion in our society and better times for the most needy and vulnerable.
Tuesday 5 November	CMS ask for prayer for mission partners working in this country, living the gospel message through their work with community groups.
Wednesday 6 November	Pray for the work of the Children's Society in our area.
Thursday 7 November	Pray for the work of the Leprosy Mission in Nepal and also for their mobile clinics working in difficult and dangerous circumstances in Myanmar.
Friday 8 November	Pray for an end to attacks and retaliations throughout the Middle East and that humanitarian aid will reach where it is so greatly needed.
