



Sunday 4 February	Pray for the leaders of nations, for peace and justice at home and for an end to conflict in the many troubled parts of the world.
Monday 5 February	Pray for members of our national parliament of all parties, for the wisdom and courage to support what is just and good.
Tuesday 6 February	Pray for Christians in Sudan and all the people suffering there as power struggles between rival factions continue.
Wednesday 7 February	Pray for our CMS partner Awais and for CMS workers Chris and Suzy in Ethiopia where they work with local Christian leaders and Chris travels around the country to train church leaders in refugee camps.
Thursday 8 February	In the 150th year since its formation, the Leprosy Mission ask for our prayers for people and communities affected by leprosy throughout the world.
Friday 9 February	Pray for any young people in our area who have not settled back into school or college after the disruptions of lockdown and school closures for structural repairs.
Saturday 10 February	Pray for the people who come to the places of warmth, company and refreshment provided by our churches and other village organisations through the winter months.
