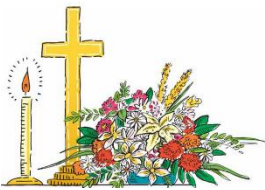
Would anyone like to volunteer to run the competition for the 2025/2026 season?
